Bethany UCC Council Meeting: Wednesday April 10, 2019

Present: Jan Charton, Pastor Kim Cran, Sue Gaskill, Bob Pletzer, John Seymour, John Wachovec

Not Present: Harry Cool, Andy McVan, Laura Rorrer

Next Meeting: Wednesday May 8, 2019 at 7:00 PM

Discussion:

- 1. John W called the meeting to order at 7:02 PM. Pastor Kim then shared our opening prayer.
- March 13th and April 1st Council Meeting Minutes: Bob motioned for approval. John W seconded. Passed.
 Pastor's Report:
 - Pastor Installation: This has been scheduled for the morning of Sunday September 22nd.
 - Vacation: She will be on vacation May $9^{th} 22^{nd}$ and July $11^{th} 21^{st}$.
 - Study Leave: Pastor Kim will be away August $15^{th} 21^{st}$ and October $17^{th} 23^{rd}$.
 - Substitutes: Jan volunteered to schedule supply pastors for the Sundays Kim is not here. We discussed then potential alternative programs for some of the associated worship services.
 - 100 Anniversary T-Shirts: We were reminded these can now be ordered.
- 4. Finance Committee:
 - OCWM: The D L Powers Scholarship Fund money was used for OCWM. Mission Committee will also have a special offering for OCWM in September.
 - Gift Cards: Current Card vendor will be shutting down. As the new supplier does not carry the Acme card, it will be discontinued when our existing supply runs out.
 - Boiler Condensate Line: Property Committee's request for an additional \$100 was approved.
- 5. Building Use:
 - Safe Church Policy: States two adults must be present when activities at Bethany involve minors. John S sought clarification on the actual associated age. Pastor Kim noted we should interpret this to mean those under the age of 18. Council agreed by consensus.
 - Fee Schedule: John S proposed and Bob seconded the motion that the finalized fee schedule be approved and included in our Building Use Policy. Motion passed.
 - Organ Use: We agreed potential users should be vented by the Music Committee.
 - Weddings and Funeral: It was suggested we may wish to include these activities in the Building Use Policy.
 - Building Use Policy: John S will distribute the current policy to Council for review and suggestion of other potential policy updates for consideration at our next Council meeting.
- 6. Church Committees:
 - Congregation Interest Sheets: John S will distribute the current sheet to Council. Members are requested to suggest changes to bring this up-to-date at our next meeting.
 - Newsletter Articles: John W will send a message to the committee chairs requesting their involvement and support. We would like the newsletter to include informative and promotional article throughout the year making the congregation aware of their existence, activities and opportunities.
- 7. Executive Session: Church Council then entered Executive Session to discuss items related to current renters and renter applicants of our building rooms.
- 8. John W adjourned the meeting at 8:45 PM following the sharing of the Lord's Prayer.
